



RÁQUIRA



The town of Ráquira in central Colombia has been famous for its artisan craftsmanship for centuries. The town and the surrounding area was home to the Taquira people until Spanish conquistadors discovered the area in what is currently the Boyacá province in 1537. During our visit to Ráquira, we will get hands on making our own handicraft.



STAGE 2

Cajicá – Villa de Leyva

We will ride around colorful mountains that make up the Boyaca region. This route takes us to the Famous “Boyaca Bridge” an emblematic place where Colombia won the last battle for its independence from the Spanish. 
MONGUI

OBLIGATIONS

You must: follow the instructions of your professional Viraba Bike Travels guide at all times; make sure you have an adequate level of physical condition to participate in your trip.

Notify us of any medical ailments you suffer that may affect your ability to participate in the trip; always wear a helmet while riding a bike. Do not pedal under the influence of alcohol or psychoactive substances. Insurance: all tour prices include basic medical insurance; however, it is your responsibility to ensure that your personal insurance covers all of your personal requirements, including cancellation and repatriation charges in the event of an accident or illness. Your insurance should also cover you for cycling activities and associated risks, as well as your luggage and cycling equipment.

TRIP CANCELLATION

If you wish to cancel your reservation, you must notify us of this by emailing us at info@virababiketravels.com. Once we receive your cancellation notice, we will follow up with an email confirming your cancellation. Your cancellation will take effect from the date you receive our email confirming your cancellation. In the event you cancel your trip, the following cancellation charges will apply (charges are expressed as a percentage of the total price of your trip):

- More than 30 days before departure: your deposit *
- Between 30 and 10 days before departure: 50% of the trip fee;
- 10 to 0 days before departure: 100% of the trip fee.

You have the right to request the transfer of your deposit only if you inform us at least 30 days before

your departure date by emailing us at info@virababiketravels.com. Your deposit will be transferable for 1 calendar year from the date of payment. Please note that deposits are non-refundable and can be transferred to another outlet only once.
